

**<sup>10</sup> Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.**

# Purpose Driven

### A passage for your group to discuss:

**Ephesians 1:17-19**

<sup>17</sup> That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him:

<sup>18</sup> The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,

<sup>19</sup> And what is the exceeding greatness of his power to us-ward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power,

<sup>21</sup>He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.

Mark 11:22-26 King James Version (KJV)

<sup>22</sup> And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God.

<sup>23</sup> For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

<sup>24</sup> Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.

<sup>25</sup> And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses.

<sup>26</sup> But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses.

<sup>23</sup> Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.

<sup>24</sup> And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts.

<sup>25</sup> If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.

<sup>13</sup>Ye call me Master and Lord: and ye say well; for so I am.

<sup>14</sup>If I then, your Lord and Master, have washed your feet; ye also ought to wash one another's feet.

<sup>15</sup>For I have given you an example, that ye should do as I have done to you.

# **Spirit Driven**

**61** The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound;

<sup>6</sup>Is not this the fast that I have chosen? to loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that ye break every yoke?

<sup>7</sup>Is it not to deal thy bread to the hungry, and that thou bring the poor that are cast out to thy house? when thou seest the naked, that thou cover him; and that thou hide not thyself from thine own flesh?

<sup>8</sup>Then shall thy light break forth as the morning, and thine health shall spring forth speedily: and thy righteousness shall go before thee; the glory of the LORD shall be thy reward.
